Pupil Premium is allocated to all schools where there are children who are entitled to free school meals, are looked after or who have parents who are in the Armed Forces.

How will the Pupil Premium be spent at Bishop Pursglove?

Pupil Premium Spending 2019/2020

£13080 was received and is planned to be spent in the following ways:

- 19 additional TA hours to support, and provide intervention where necessary, for Pupil Premium pupils - £11913
- A small reserve of funds is held in school to support Pupil Premium children who may struggle to pay for school trips, uniform, lunches, Ipads and residential - £1500

Total: £13413

How well do the children receiving Pupil Premium do at Bishop Pursglove?
